Below are some important things to consider, frequently asked questions and legal jargon.*

Doors open at 5:30pm. Beverages & candy will be sold at the inside bar. Restrooms are available inside. Please wear a mask when in the building. Food trucks and the bar accept cash and credit cards.

A short intermission will take place between movies.

This allows you to stretch your legs as well as chance to charge your vehicle battery by running the car.

If you feel the need to run around like a banshee, please do so in the grass to the side of the screen.

We plan to park larger vehicles together, to afford everyone the best view of the screen.

Headlights and exterior lighting must be off during the movie.

Please research how to shut off your lights before arriving.

Sound is broadcast in FM only. If you are concerned that your car battery will run down, please bring a battery powered, portable FM radio. Apps on phones do not work unless you have a built in FM antenna

We ask that you take home any trash or use the garbage cans around building.

**DO NOT THROW IT ON THE GROUND** or we will rub it in your hair.

You may NOT sit on the roof of your car.

Please see management if this was a legitimate question you were going to ask.

Pets are not allowed. Grilling is not allowed. Grilling pets is not allowed.

Lawn chairs and blankets are permitted. You may also sit in the bed of your truck.

Or someone else's truck. Please confirm you were invited first.

Campers/RVs are not permitted. Any campers attempting to park in the lot will be required to cook yummy food for all movie attendees.

Is smoking allowed? Smoking is bad, mkay? However, we do have designated spots by the patio.

No butts are to be thrown on the ground, due to it being gross.

Keep your children under direct supervision of a guardian at all times. Do not allow them to roam grounds unaccompanied. Children found to be disruptive will be asked to remain in vehicle.
